

Private Residence

This grand residence, complete with guest wing and caretakers' quarters, investigates traditions of the Western American Arts & Crafts movement. With acute attention to detail and a meticulous rendering of indigenous materials the house blends comfortably into the wooded setting, framed by distant mountains.

The Main House contains a great room, dining room, media room, private office, two junior master guest suites, and a master suite with a sitting room, dressing rooms, two bathrooms, and an outdoor jacuzzi.

The basement includes a wine cellar and tasting room, a telecommunications room, a gym, a flower preparation room, and an underground storage/mud room linking the garage and main house.

A log and stone guest wing contains four bedrooms, bunk room, yoga room, a sitting/dining/great room, and a screened porch connection to the main house that contains a spa with a sauna and jacuzzi.

The caretaker's garage has two bedrooms with baths, a living area and kitchen, five parking spaces and an underground connection to the basement.
