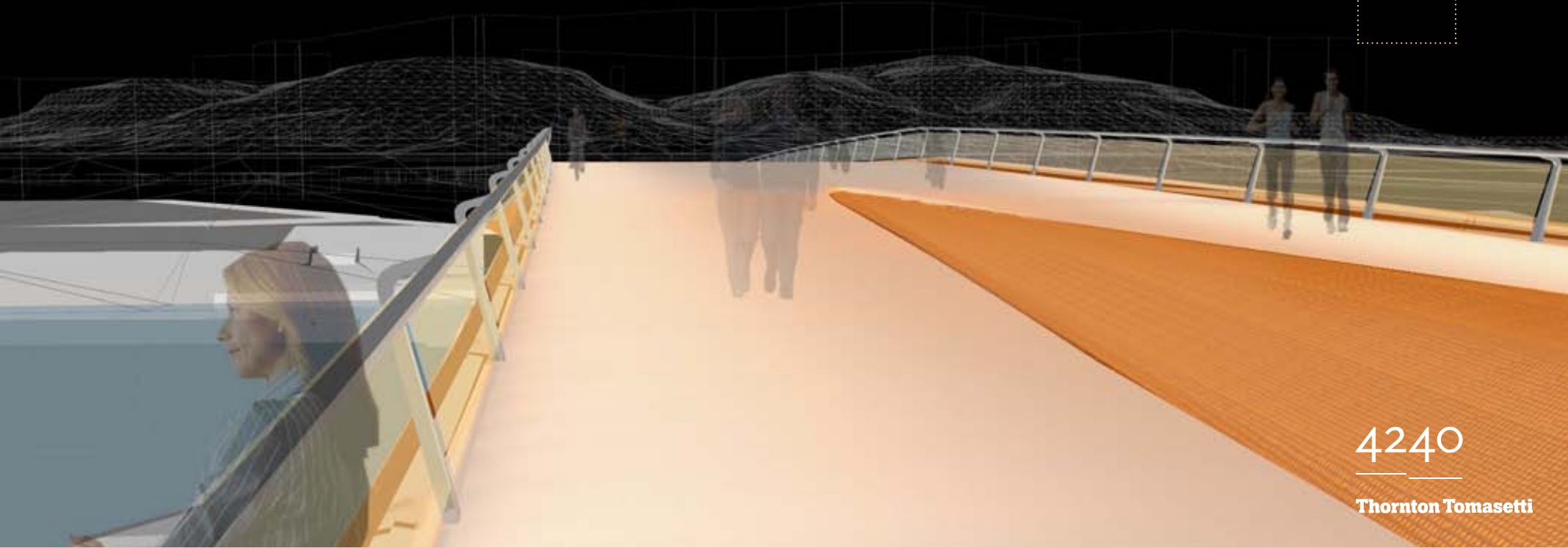

Spanning over the genesis point of the Ohio River, this glow-in-the-dark bridge structure measures only 24' tall at mid-span. Impossible in steel or concrete, the 1,600' span would be the:

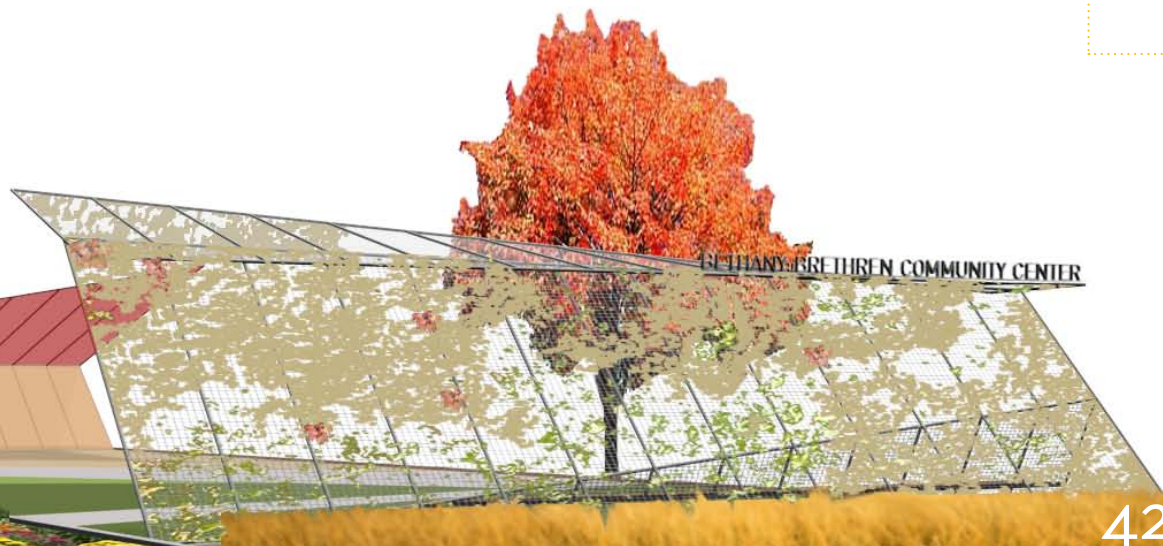
